Dear Walter Johnson Parents, Students, and Alumni,

The Walter Johnson Education Foundation spent the last few years supporting enhancements to the bricks and mortar of the modernization of the school. Now we turn our focus into the building and to making our great programs become excellent ones. The modernization substantially upgraded the media center—in fact moved it from an old, convoluted space to the new location outfitted with technology and great work areas for students and staff. Now it is time to support updating the collections- both print and media to the level that our staff and students should have.

We are working with our new Media Specialist, Naomi Gelfand, to identify the most urgent areas of need. She reports that there are ample on-line sources for students to use, but books and other print media or play-aways are seriously lacking in both quantity and quality. Books on science, technology, economics, or the digital arts must be recently published to be most useful. Many resources are available electronically but students still need to have a broad range of print and media sources at school to develop research skills. And we want to encourage the love of reading by providing an abundance of current fiction.

MCPS provides an annual budget for the media center and a portion of this is used for on-line subscriptions for resources such as encyclopedias and databases. But to truly bring our media center to where it needs to be will take many thousands of dollars. The PTSA recently donated \$1000 and the Ed Foundation allocated \$5000. We will donate the proceeds of the joint PTSA, Booster and Ed Foundation Adult Carnival this winter to the Media Center Collection. We are optimistically hoping to raise \$30, 000 this year.

Ms. Gelfand is busy selecting new materials based on her expertise and to fulfill requests from students and staff. MCPS policy requires all books to be approved to be allowed for media center use. Ms. Gelfand is requesting approval of numerous new books and media, including current fiction, anime novels, and non-fiction sources. In addition, library bindings make books that are borrowed by many readers last much longer. Therefore, we are requesting that donations to the Media Center be through a newly established fund or in consultation with Ms. Gelfand.
